Youth Mental Health First Aid (YMHFA) teaches adults how to identify, understand, and respond to signs of mental health challenges in youth. This training gives adults the skills they need to reach out and provide initial support to youth and connect them to the appropriate care.



Intended Participants: This course is designed for any adult who works with students ages 6-18. Classified and certificated district or school staff are encouraged to attend, including teachers, counselors, office staff, coaches, etc...

Full attendance is mandatory for this seven hour Youth Mental Health First Aid course. All attendees will receive a three-year YMHFA certification.
